There are no appearances by any party.

The Court is in receipt of and has read and considered defendant's ex parte application for a temporary restraining order enjoining plaintiff from demolishing or altering the property; stay of execution of the judgment pending defendant's motion to vacate the judgment and resolution of a bankruptcy action; restore defendant to possession of the property; and to shorten time for hearing on defendant's motion to vacate judgment currently set for June 27, 2025.

Defendant's ex parte application to shorten time for hearing defendant's motion to vacate the judgment is granted, and time is shortened to the time of the ex parte applications.

The remainder of defendant's ex parte motions and the motion to vacate the judgment are denied.

Defendant failed to comply with ex parte notice requirements pursuant to California Rules of Court, rule 3.1204.

Code of Civil Procedure section 473, subdivision (b), provides that the court may relieve a party from a judgment taken against him or her through mistake, inadvertence, surprise or excusable neglect. Surprise refers to "some condition or situation in which a party . . . is unexpectedly placed to his injury without any default or negligence of his own, which ordinary prudence could not have guarded against." (State Farm Fire & Cas. Co. v. Pietak (2001) 90 Cal.App.4th 600, 611.) Inadvertence relates to circumstances that could not have been avoided through the exercise of reasonable care and prudence. (Elms v. Elms (1946) 72 CalApp.2d 508, 513.) A party demonstrates excusable neglect by showing circumstances could not have been avoided with reasonable care and prudence. (Id. At p. 513.) Moreover, an application for relief under Code of Civil Procedure section 473, subdivision (b), must be made within a reasonable time, but no later than six months.

Defendant was personally served with the Summons and Complaint in this matter on March 1, 2025. (ROA 12.) Defendant failed to respond to the Complaint, and default was entered against him on March 17, 2025, and a default judgment for possession only was entered on March 18, 2025 (ROA 17, 18.) A

writ of possession was issued on March 22, 2025 (ROA 23).

Defendant does not contend that he was not properly served. Citing Lasalle v. Vogel (2019) 36 Cal.App.5th 127, and other cases, defendant argues that the default should be set aside because plaintiff's counsel did not warn him that of the impending default and in support of his contention. Those cases are inapplicable here, as those cases involved a landlord's counsel's ethical duty to advise defense counsel before requesting entry of default.

On these facts, the Court does not find that the judgment was entered against defendant due to surprise, excusable neglect, or inadvertence pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 473, subdivision (b), as defendant was personally served with the Summons and Complaint on March 1, 2025, and chose not to act. Therefore, the defendant has not established a basis for relief. Accordingly, the motion to vacate the default is denied.

In addition, even if the Court had set aside the default and default judgment, the defendant's ex parte request to restore possession and the email attached as Exhibit D to defendant's motion to vacate the judgment support a finding that this Court has no jurisdiction to grant the requested relief. In the May 10, 2025 email from plaintiff's counsel to defendant, plaintiff's counsel stated that defendant left personal property at the subject premises after he moved out. Defendant cites no legal authority, and the court is aware of none, authorizing the court to grant any relief post-lockout, absent a reversal on appeal. (See Code Civ. Proc., §§ 1210 [person who is evicted from rental premises by judgment or process of court and who reenters or takes possession is in contempt of court]; 1179 [after forfeiture, tenant may apply to court for relief before landlord retakes premises]; 908 [appellate court may order restitution after reversal].)

Accordingly, at this stage of the litigation, there is no remedy the court can grant.

There are no appearances by any party.

The Court is in receipt of and has read and considered defendant's ex parte application for reconsideration of the Court's denial of defendant's ex parte application for a temporary restraining order, vacating a "void" judgment, stay of the unlawful detainer action, and restoration of possession pending resolution of defendant's motion to vacate the judgment and a related "bankruptcy adversary proceeding."

The ex parte application for reconsideration is denied. Defendant has not raised new or different facts, circumstances, or law as required under Civil Code of Procedure section 1008, subdivision (a). Instead, defendant argues that the Minute Order issued on May 21, 2025 (ROA 51), denying defendant's ex parte application is void because it failed to address defendant's arguments, specifically, that the default judgment is void due to due process violations, lack of notice, rejected pro se filings, that the unlawful detainer action relies on a void 2017 judgment and wrongful foreclosure and that the Court incorrectly applied Code of Civil Procedure section 473, subdivision (b).

The Court, while not explicitly stating that it does not find the judgment was void, the Court explicitly found that default was properly entered against defendant because the judgment was not entered against defendant due to surprise, excusable neglect, or inadvertence pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 473, subdivision (b). Therefore, it follows that the Court did not find that judgment was void, or that defendant's due process rights were violated. The Court further found that the cases cited by defendant regarding plaintiffs' attorneys' ethical obligation to inform defense counsel of an impending default were inapplicable, and therefore, defendant's due process rights were not violated. The remainder of the Court's May 21, 2025 Minute Order is sufficiently clear.
